### Maths

In maths, we will be learning a variety of new skills such as, counting in steps of 2, 3 and 5 from zero, and in tens from any number, forward and backward, recognise the place value of each digit in a two-digit number and read and write numbers to at least 100 in numerals and in words. We will also be learning how to add and subtract numbers using concrete objects, pictorial representation and mentally,

Music. In music, we will be learning about a number of instruments such as glockenspiels, steel pans and chime bars. We will learn about the tempo, pitch and dynamics and how these are all changeable in music before learning how to clap in time to the beat independently.

## English

In English, we will be basing our reading and writing units around 5 core texts; Burglar Bill, Flat Stanley, The Twits, The Worst Witch and The Enchanted Wood. During each unit we will be learning a range of different grammatical skills which we will need to enable us to write in a number of ways such as; an adventure story, non-chronological report, character description, diary entry, and persuasive writing.

<u>Geography.</u>

In geography, we will be learning

about Africa and Blyth. We will

be comparing Africa to England

and Blyth as well as looking at

the similarities and differences. We

will also be looking at Blyth and

the surrounding areas and how

the port, shops, houses and

harbours have ended up where

they are.

French

In French, we will be learning

numbers up to 10, the days of the

week and how to sing 'head,

shoulders, krees and toes. We will

also be learning the French words

to name 10 fruits as well as

learning how to ask 'do you like?'

and being able to respond with 'I

like or I dislike' We will learn at

least 5 animals as well as being

able to ask 'do you like...?'

# Religious Education In R.E we will be learning about Christian, Judaism and Buddhism beliefs and practices. We will be looking at what makes a Christian, what Jewish people believe in and how they celebrate their beliefs and how Buddhists show their beliefs.

#### Computing

In computing, we are going to learn how to create and share a programmed animation which transitions between slides. We will also be learning how to create a PowerPoint presentation which includes an image, a video and animation and make a story with text and moving pictures.

#### <u>Science</u>

In science, we will be learning about how animals, including humans, need to eat, drink and breathe to stay alive and that both animals and humans have offspring which grow into adults. We will be looking at different materials and why a certain material is suitable/unsuitable for an object. We will also be learning about plants and how they grow from a seed or bulb need that is the same as their parent plant. We will then learn about how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.

# History

In history, we will be learning castles, why they were built and what impact they had on the area. What was the same and what was different about The Great Fire of London and Newcastle, what life was like during WW2 and how Blyth town centre has changed over the last 100 years.

## <u>Art.</u>

In art, we will be looking at one of the world's greatest artists, Vincent van Gogh. We will be looking at how he used bold, dramatic brush strokes to express emotion and add feeling to his work. We will also be using a range of material to create layers in artwork incorporating the style of Van Gogh. 🔬
