English

In English, we will be basing our reading and writing units around 3 core texts; The Witches, Varjak Paw and There's a Boy in the Girl's Bathroom. During each unit we will be learning a range of different grammatical skills which we will need to enable us to write in a number of ways such as; a setting description, diary entry, balanced argument, persuasive letter, Newspaper report and a poem.

Religious Education

In R.E we will be learning about

also be learning about Sikhism

and Hinduism, where they

worship and what their beliefs

and practices are.

Computing

In computing, we are going to

design, create and code our own

Lego model using programmable

sensors. We will also be making

which will be worked on

collaboratively and presented to

the rest of the class.

<u>Science</u>

In science, we will be learning about how sounds are made and that vibrations are sounds travelling through a medium to the ear. We will then learn about the basic parts of the digestive system. In Electricity and Circuits, we will be will be learning how to construct a simple circuit as well as being able to name the basic parts of a circuit. Towards the end of the year we will be looking at the different states of matter and grouping materials according to whether they are a solid, liquid or a gas.

History

In history, we will be learning about how Britain has changed across the period of the Vikings, Anglo Saxons, Celts and Scots. We will also be looking at the causes and consequences of WW2 on people living in Britain. Then we'll look at how the changes to the Port of Blyth have impacted on the community.

Art.

In art, we are going to be drawing with scissors. This means we will be cutting out shapes from paper to make pieces of artwork. We will be also be learning about a great artist from the 1900s called 'Henri Matisse' who created large scale collages using coloured paper.
